

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Gospel Jn 14:15-21

The Christian life is

not an external observance of Christ's commandments but an intense relationship of the community to the three Persons of the Trinity, each with a specific role to play in this relationship. The Spirit conveys the presence of the Son, who reveals the Father.

The departure of Jesus does not mean that he is now absent. It means his ever-renewed presence through the coming of the Spirit to the community. That is the Easter message of this Gospel reading.
