

THIRD SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Gospel Matthew 4:12-23

Following Jesus means to repent for the here and now, not the then and there. It is motivated by compassion for this world, not our concern with our own reward or punishment in a future realm. It is often noted that Matthew used the term "kingdom of heaven" rather than "kingdom of God." Many readers assume Jesus was talking about heaven in the popular sense of a place souls ascend to after death. But Matthew's use of the term "kingdom of heaven" doesn't refer to a purely future, otherworldly locale. It is his way of saying "kingdom of God" out of reverence for the Sovereign Creator.
