



It seems strange that Jesus would tell his disciples not to reveal that he was the Christ (the Messiah). But the problem was that many people of the time had different

ideas about what the Messiah was supposed to be. So Jesus spent a lot of time trying to persuade people to rethink the whole concept of Messiah.

Jesus had to redefine Messiah for them in light of the prophecies of Isaiah chapter 53, concerning the one who suffers for the sake of others. Jesus would achieve victory through suffering. Peter had a partial understanding, though not through his own insight. It was revealed to him by God.

Most Catholics are familiar with the moment when Jesus makes Peter the first leader of the Apostles, giving him the keys. But there is something else equally important here. Jesus made a promise to Peter and the other Apostles that the Church will be built on a rock (Mt 7:23-25), and the "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." This means that the forces if evil will never completely overcome the Church.


