**24th Sunday** in Ordinary Time **Gospel: Mark** 

8:27-35

Peter recoils at Jesus' revelation that as "the Christ" he must "suffer greatly ... be rejected ... be killed, and rise after three days." Peter, is so aghast at Jesus' words about suffering and death that he fails to hear the most important part of the revelation about who Jesus is and what he is to accomplish. He fails to grasp that through death Jesus will be raised to new life. Hearing Jesus' teaching about taking up his cross to follow him can cause us similarly to recoil as did Peter. But we live on the other side of the resurrection. We know that death brings risen life. This assurance of new life is what gives us the courage to "take up [our] cross, and follow" Jesus.
