Paradisus Dei's TMIY program is a faith filled men's formation program that honestly addresses the pressures and temptations that men face in our modern culture, especially those relating to our roles as husbands and fathers. The program brings together current social and medical science with the teachings of the Church and the wisdom of the Saints to develop the vision of man fully alive. The program will be hosted every Thursday morning at 6:00 AM, starting September 16. The program is 26 weeks, meeting weekly for 13 weeks before Christmas and then 13 weeks before Easter. Each weekly session has three essential elements: social gathering (10 min), DVD presentation (20 - 30 min), and small group discussion (30 Min), concluding before 7:30 AM and enabling most men to be at work by 8:00 AM.
