A WORD FROM FATHER BRANDON

What a phenomenal summer picnic we had last weekend! With the weather having cleared up on Sunday, we had a huge crowd and a great time! We don't take a headcount, but it looks like somewhere around 325 came for the picnic! I was told it was the largest crowd in recent memory. Regardless of the headcount, it was great family time to be together with each other, and it was a lot of fun talking to so many and seeing everyone there! I am happy we have this tradition here, and that we can do it right here on our property. I know most parishes do not have that luxury of so much real estate like we do to throw up tents, grill, and serve so much food right beside the church – whoever acquired and for whatever reason they acquired all this land, I thank them! Most parishes must go rent pavilions at a park, often miles away, and that is just a layer of friction for bringing the parish family together. In my previous two parishes, we had to go miles away, and that made it difficult for those with mobility issues or those who just do not typically drive far from home. It's not just the property that is a gift to have, it's all of you that really see this and want to continue make this into a real family where we may not be connected and united by blood (though I keep finding out so many of you are!) but rather by our common love for Christ and wanting this little nook of the creation to be brilliant and resplendent with that love shining forth! I briefly touched on last week about so many projects that were undertaken over these summer months and how we had an incredible sense of all hands-on deck – much like you'd have in a family – to see that our house would truly be a home for us and for those who will one day come to be part of this family! The summer picnic was no light task, either, in its planning and execution. But, because of the profound dedication to our parish family, it happens so wondrously! As I said last week, I love being pastor here and being able to be part of something so simple (like family) yet profoundly beautiful (again, like family!)! To all who were part of the picnic planning and working – thank you for your commitment to our family!

Just a little heads up about the use of my time heading into the academic year. I desire to be more present to both the SMS children and to the Faith Formation students. I love teaching and I love being around both of those groups of students as they strive to encounter God in new and beautiful ways. This coming year, I will be available for, roughly, every other Faith Formation session. In particular, I will be collaborating with the Confirmation catechists, but will make my way around to other classes throughout the year. This means that about once or twice a month throughout the academic year, I will not be able to take the Sunday 9:00AM Mass. I have spent hours and hours trying to find a way to not miss Masses and yet be present for Faith Formation. I don't like that we have a Mass during that time – I don't know of another solution, though, right now, as it is a one priest parish, but it is what it is. I will just need to have coverage for a handful of 9:00 Masses throughout the year. It is a sacrifice for me, as I LOVE being with you at each Mass on Sunday, but I need to do what I need to do. Secondly, I will be teaching a religion class over in the school during the week. This will be a class in the mornings, after Mass, so we may need to have later AM / early afternoon funerals, for instance, on school days. Again, it may be an inconvenience to some, but I need to prioritize the formation and education of our youth in both programs, so it will necessitate some sacrifices here and there, and may not make me as 100% available as some may want. I won't apologize, though! And thirdly, I am looking to have a very part-time office space over at Thiel and make myself available one day a week for a few hours so I can be there for confessions and conversation with students who may need to speak to a priest. Thiel is part of the ministry here, and I am looking forward to making myself available to them in that capacity. Being among students is a huge part of being pastor here, and I feel I was not good at that this past year. I also felt something was missing in me. I am looking forward to being present in these ministries of ours and to be present over at Thiel in a new capacity. Most may not even notice the changes in my schedule, but I wanted to make you all aware that I will be using my time more effectively to benefit our students and their faith!


