A WORD FROM FR. BRANDON

Something I have come to not like about standard practice among parishes is that confessions are consistently solely offered on Saturday afternoons. No matter where you look, that is a near-universal reality in parishes. I must be frank - if I wasn't a priest, the last thing I think I'd want to be doing on many Saturday afternoons is squeezing in a confession! I'm not dumb, I know people live lives, and they should, and that Saturday afternoon is one of the most precious times of the week for so many, so it is a sort of a shortsighted 'boilerplate' practice. If that practice were personified or anthropomorphized, I envision it saying, *"if you want your sins forgiven, stop what you're doing in the middle of your weekend, and get to confession! What, is that inconvenient? Were you busy hanging out and having fun with your kids and family? Think about how Christ suffered on a Friday afternoon, you think His weekend was interrupted? You can get to confession on a Saturday"*, or something stupid like that! With that said, I have been overwhelmed by how full the hour is on Saturdays! This is a parish that takes that sacrament seriously! I have gotten into the habit over the years of bringing a book in with me, or a notebook or a journal so I have something to read or work on while I'm waiting for the time to pass - I've not read a sentence of any book I've brought in or have written anything down in the confessional here! It's been great! I would, though, like to offer additional confession times so that those who are unable to get to confession on Saturdays, and who do not want to wait for the Lenten and Advent confession times, can get to the sacrament more regularly. I would like to set, beginning Tuesday, Sep. 6, **Tuesdays from 8:00 - 8:30 PM** as an additional confession time. My thinking with this time is that come nightfall, our commitments, obligations, meetings, and work are done and we're settling in for the night and most are probably just sitting watching tv or reading a book or just doing whatever your nightly routines are. I'd like to offer this time so that after you get the kids to sleep, or your day is done and you're just unwinding, you can simply hop over to the church and get a confession in before bed on Tuesdays (I'm also adding Tuesday confessions at Thiel in the afternoons, so it'll be a great day of confessions for me - I love hearing confessions). Those weeks when I happen to be away on a Tuesday evening, I'll simply alert you in my article that week and post it on the door to get the word out. Along that same vein, my practice is to offer a tranche of additional confession times during the Advent and Lenten Seasons, so those will be made available when those seasons come around. (We're only 13 weeks from Advent - I can't wait!) As a priest, from the other side of the screen, I have come to really love the ministry of being Christ for people in that moment of great vulnerability, sorrow, and contrition.

After nearly ten years and three months of priesthood, I would guesstimate that I have been graced with the opportunity to be Christ's ear and voice in that moment roughly about eleven thousand times! I have heard confessions on three continents and in about a half-dozen states. I can honestly say that I have absolutely no memory of any person's sin! You hear that as a Catholic, the priest doesn't remember your sins. I'm sure it's probably received as some sort of marketing ploy to get you to confession - but it really is true, a Grace of God! What I do have, though, are memories of a few moments within those eleven thousand encounters that were nothing short of beautiful and divine. I have sat with any number of both women and men where we cry and name the babies they had lost to abortion decades ago and pray for those kids' intercession, and ask Mary and Joseph to be their mommies and daddies in heaven until their earthly parents can get there. I have sat with people who struggled with the will and desire to live, and I wouldn't let them leave till I was sure they were ok and safe. I have sat with people who have been away from God for years or decades because of some great darkness they've found themselves in, and we unpeel the thick-caked layers of sin and pain from their lives together; you can see their minds and souls become a thousand pounds lighter. I have sat with people who were battling great demons, addictions, and pure evil, and we battle them together. I have sat with men and women who have hit rock bottom sitting in jail, crying out to God for forgiveness for the things that had brought them there. I could go on and on about the opportunity God has given me through this vocation to be with people in their most vulnerable and painful, and that I can bring them healing and relief with the cool, soothing, Grace of Mercy! I do not and have never looked at anyone and seen their sins! It simply does not happen! I simply have a smattering of memories of some beautiful moments where I was able to be witness to God being God, and there is nothing that compares! People say there are no miracles...become a priest and you would have a change of heart!
