Some have asked that communion be distributed as we did with the blessed palms, but that is not permitted. The palms are a sacramental (sign of something holy) whereas the Blessed Sacrament is the real presence of Christ and cannot be “passed out” in a drive through manner. In fact, during this time, distribution of Communion or administration of the Sacrament of the Sick may only be given by a priest to someone in danger of death.

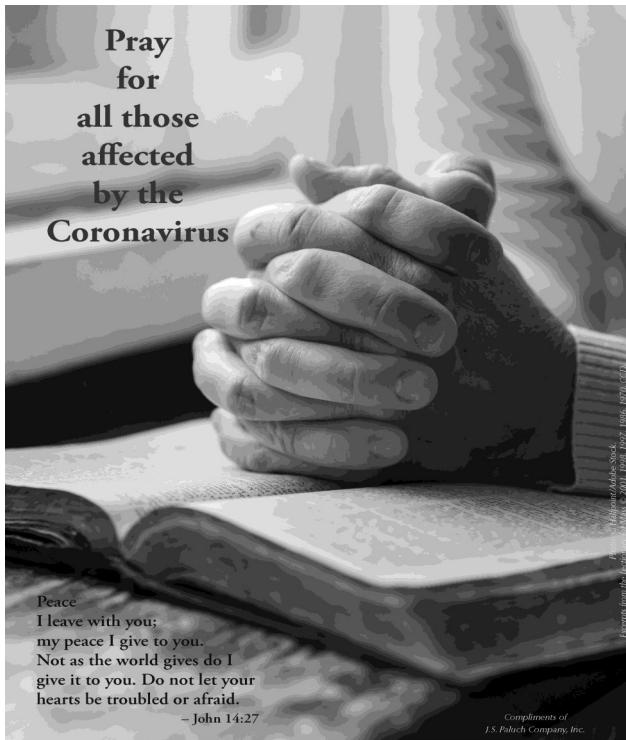
