A WORD FROM FATHER BRANDON

Our days of Lent have drawn to a close, and the holy days of the Paschal Triduum have culminated into this feast of all feasts, the Resurrection of Our Lord! Happy Easter to everyone! This Day begins a weeks-long season of joy and festivity contemplating what it means for us to not only have been saved and to have had Heaven opened for us, but also what it means for us to be Church. A hallmark of the Easter Season is that we delve guite deeply into the Acts of the Apostles where we see the earliest days of the Church, post resurrection, Ascension, and Pentecost. These feasts will punctuate the end of the Eater Season, but we will spend the days in preparation for these feasts witnessing the effects of the Resurrection - Easter. Easter, as we will see throughout this season, is not just given to us to think about the Resurrection for weeks on end, but to see Its effects and what it means in the life of the Church. There is really no better treasury of words to read and pray through to see the effects of the Resurrection than the Acts of the Apostles. The Easter Season will take us through roughly 50% of the Book of Acts. I encourage you, as we walk through these weeks of the Easter Season, that you bring Acts into your practice of spiritual reading. The easiest way for that would be just to read the daily Mass readings. Or, if you wanted to - and maybe the better and fuller option - is to just read through the Book of Acts this Easter Season. There are 28 chapters of Acts and there are 50 days of the Easter Season...you could spend just three minutes a day in it and be done by Pentecost. It really is a simple yet powerful thing to do over these coming weeks. I'm going to do that; I haven't read the whole book like that for some time - join me!

Easter is also the time where we can see the effects of our Lent being played out in our lives of faith. In our pursuit of becoming what Our Heavenly Father desires for us to become, we now see why. Why did He want us to become, ultimately, one with His Son? Because as He has desired The Son to remain with Him for eternity, The Father has also desired that we be with Him, too. As the Lord opens up paradise and soon, at The Ascension, goes home to our Father, then we, too, will join Him! Even before we join Him at the Ascension - or maybe more poignantly, at our death - we are here living as these Temples and living stones of the Temple of Christ and that means that, now in Easter, these temples are filled with not only the Love of Our Father (as we saw in Lent) but now also with the Light of the Paschal Candle - the Easter Fire - the Light of the Resurrection! If we are wedded to Christ, then we will shine like Him, too, and that means that our lives become a living Paschal Candle, in addition to Temples and children of the Father! The beauty of this life in the Church is that we keep having our identity revealed to us through the sacred and holy seasons of the Church year!

Whatever season(s) speak most to you, awesome! Embrace it and get every ounce of Grace you can from the season! For those that may speak less to you or ones that happen during times of just busyness or moments of distraction, at the very least, be a Temple, be a child of The Father, be a torch so bright and beautiful that it illuminates the dank darkness of the world sick with sin! Just be someone!
