FOOLISHNESS

Sometimes the idea of repentance seems oldfashioned, naïve, even foolish. But if you're looking for real foolishness, you'll find it in today's readings.

We begin with Leviticus and the admonition, "Take no revenge & cherish no grudge" (Leviticus 19:18). We've heard that message before, of course, so we might forget how far it is from the so-called "practical realities of life." Saint Paul warns us about being practical, though. Whoever considers oneself wise had better "become a fool," because "the wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God" (1 Corinthians 3:18, 19).

This "foolishness" continues in the Gospel: "Offer no resistance to one who is evil" (Matthew 5:39). In fact, offer the other cheek when you've been slapped. Hand over your coat as well as your shirt. Be like God, who sends sunshine & rain on the bad as well as the good. "So be perfect," says Jesus, "just as your heavenly Father is perfect" (5:48). NOTICE - LENTEN PRACTICES 2020

The season of Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 26th and concludes when the Paschal Triduum of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord begins at the start of the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 9th at 6:30 PM.

The following practices and regulations are binding for all Latin Rite Catholics in the Erie Diocese for Lent and the Paschal Triduum.

- 1. Traditional Lenten practices of **Prayer**, **Fasting & Almsgiving**, and other forms of self-denial are recommended by the Church. Daily Mass is particularly encouraged.
- 2. Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of abstinence from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older.
- 3. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are also days of Fasting for those ages 18 to 58 inclusive. On these days, those bound by the law of fasting may take one full meal. Two smaller meals sufficient to maintain strength are also permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or work is seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. On **Holy Thursday**, no celebration of the Mass is to begin anywhere in the Diocese earlier than 4:30 PM without the approval of Bishop Persico.
- 5. Although it does not include the Liturgy of the Eucharist, by its very nature the **Good Friday** Service is celebrated by a priest only.
- 6. All celebrations of the **Easter Vigil** are to begin *after nightfall*. Nightfall is about 9 PM this year. All Easter Vigil celebrations in the Erie Diocese are to begin at 9 PM or later.
