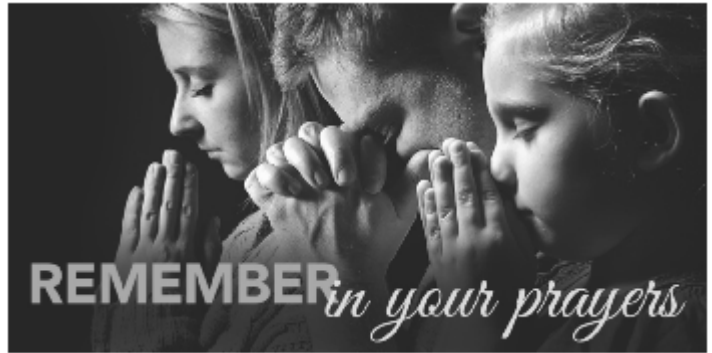
### Welcome
