Service Project: This spring, our service project will benefit St. James place in Titusville, PA.

This is a women's shelter that is in need of buckets filled with cleaning supplies that will be provided to homeless women who are starting out in a new apartment.

We are opening this up to our church families, with an expected end date of May 15th.

Your class may want to put together a bucket from the class, with each person bringing one item to class to add to a bucket, or one may want to buy the bucket, with other class members adding an item. The most expensive items that I purchased, besides the bucket (\$3), were two items that cost \$1.75 all other items cost \$1. each.....we have two classes left!

Some other items that we are collecting are personal care things like bath soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc. There can be a basket with kitchen items such as potholders, towels, dish cloths, and utensils.
