And lead me Lord, today.

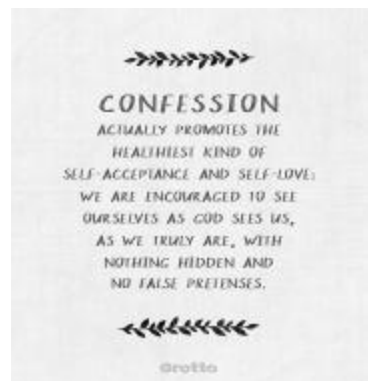
