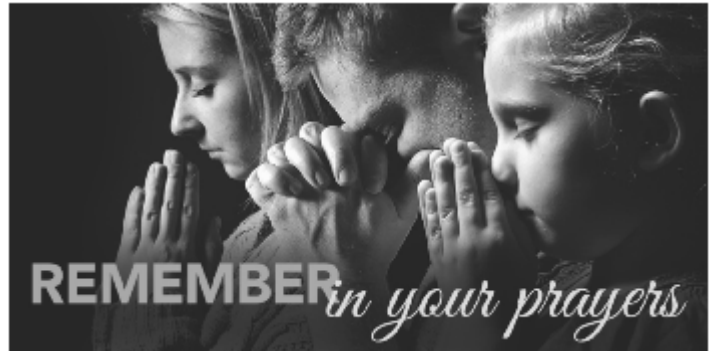



The season of lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes when the Paschal Triduum begins. Traditional Lenten practices of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving, and other forms of self-denial are recommended most warmly by the Church. Daily Mass is particularly encouraged. **ASH WEDNESDAY, ALL FRIDAYS IN LENT, and GOOD FRIDAY** are days of abstinence from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older. **ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY** are also days of fasting for those ages 18 to 58 years inclusive.
