



Lenten Regulations

The season of lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes when the Paschal Triduum begins. Traditional Lenten practices of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving, and other forms of selfdenial are recommended most warmly by the Church. Daily Mass is particularly encouraged. ASH WEDNESDAY, ALL FRIDAYS IN LENT, and GOOD FRIDAY are days of abstinence from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older. ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are also days of fasting for those ages 18 to 58 years inclusive.
