



The Family of the month is Brian and Maria Pilarcik. Besides the fact that Maria is the former Religious Ed. Director, and Brian was at one time the youngest Parish Council member in its history, they were selected for doing their best to see that the Catholic Church will be vibrant in the 22nd Century. While Michael (10), Sammy (8), Gabriel (6), William (5), Ezekiel (2) and Maggie (9 months) attend every 7:30am weekday Mass, and the three oldest boys are "by the book" Altar Servers, just Michael is old enough to receive Communion! Failure to forgive blinds us to another's goodness. Lent provides an opportunity to wash away our blind-spots in the pool of forgiveness. Listen to Jesus in today's gospel: "Go wash and see."		 The first Stations of the Cross were walked by Jesus himself on the way to Calvary. Known as the "Via Dolorosa" ("The Way of Suffering") or the "Via Crucis" ("The Way of the Cross"), it was marked out from the earliest times and was a traditional walk for pilgrims who came to Jerusalem. The early Christians in Jerusalem would walk the same pathway that Jesus walked, pausing for reflection and prayer. Later, when Christians could not travel to the Holy Land, artistic depictions of "The Way of the Cross" were set up in churches, or outside and Christians would walk from station to station, reading the Gospel account of the Passion, or simply praying and reflecting on each event. While the content or place of each station had changed, the intention was to make a mini-pilgrimage and followliterallyin the footsteps of Jesus. This devotion became better known in the Middle Ages, and the Franciscans are credited with its spread. Lent is a time when many people make the Stations and some churches present
