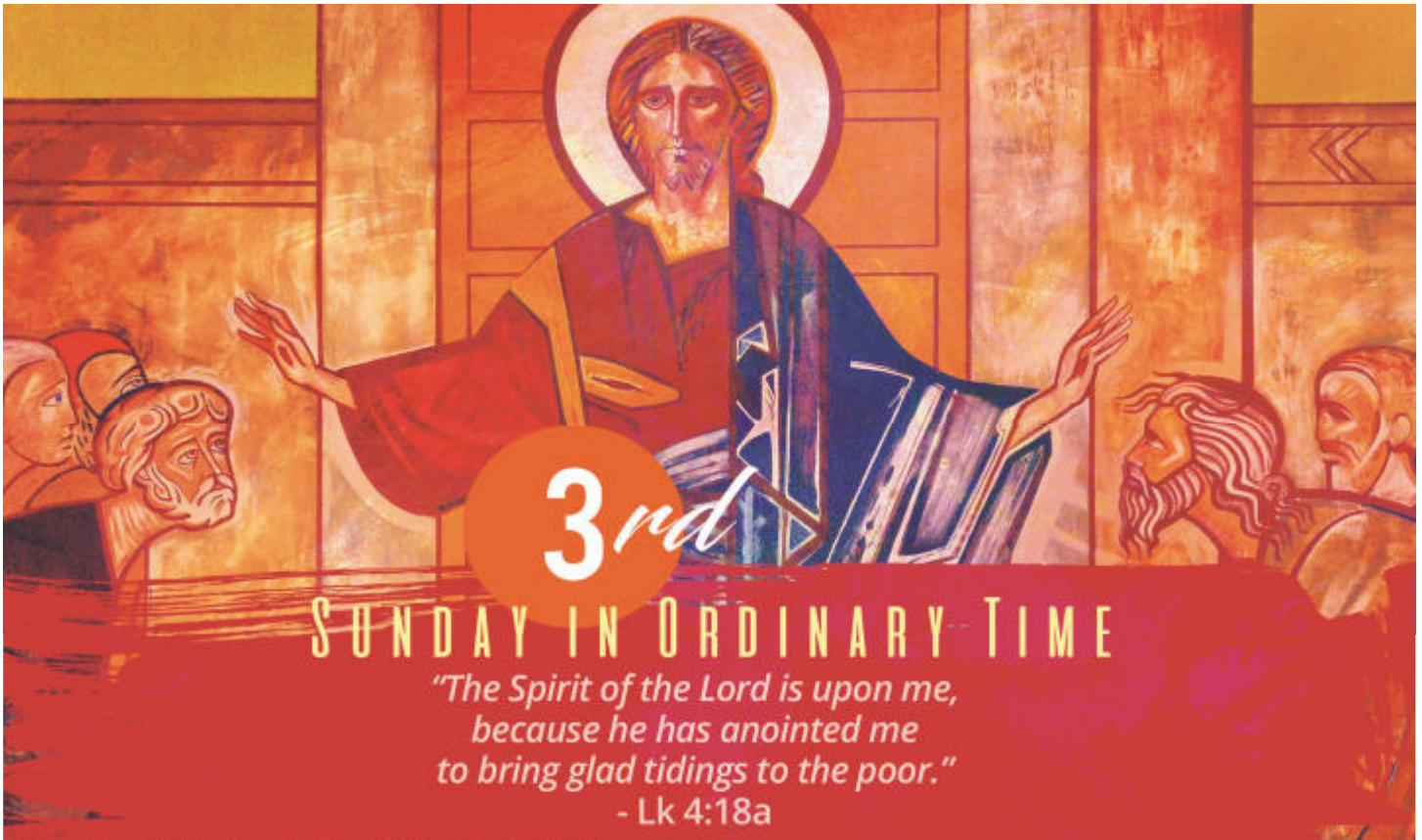

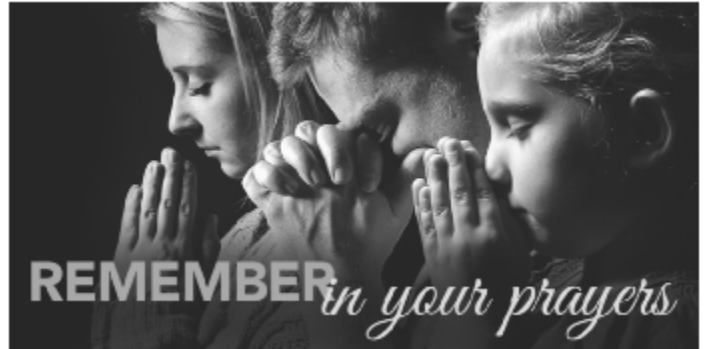
Welcome

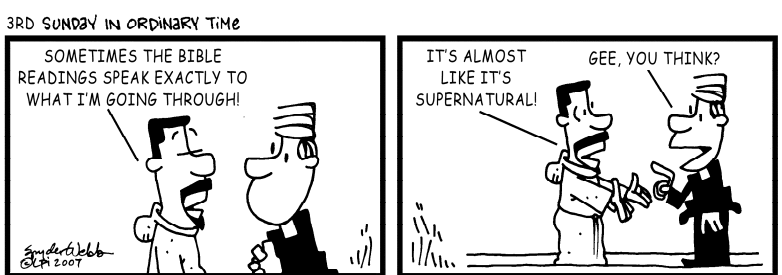
