Diocese of Erie Returns to Public Mass

I'm sure at the time of this writing you are aware that we will return to the public celebration of Mass beginning Monday, June 1st throughout the Diocese of Erie.

Our parishes are now prepared and ready to open for public worship following the protocols outlined by the CDC, the PA Dept. of Health and Bishop Persico.

It is important that all of us become familiar with the regulations that must be followed and I urge you to check the diocesan website www.erieecd.org for a complete list. Here are the main things to keep in mind:

1.) The Church is limited to 1/3 of its seating capacity. Some pews will be marked off and therefore should not be used. Please do not remove the tape that may be blocking off a pew. Your pew may not be available for use and you must only sit in an approved area. Families that live together may occupy the same pew. If there exists a 6-foot distance in the pew that is occupied, you may sit at the other end of that pew. No one except the musician is to be in the choir loft.

2.) Physical distancing must be maintained at all times. There is to be no congregating or socializing inside or outside the Church. When Mass is ended, you are to leave the Church building in an orderly fashion keeping 6 feet behind each other (with the exception of those who live together) and go directly to your vehicle.

3.) Everyone entering the Church must wear a mask or some other mouth and nose covering while in the Church. Please do not enter without it.

4.) If you do not feel well, are elderly, are uncomfortable returning to a group setting or have an issue that compromises your health, please stay home. There is no Mass obligation for any Catholic during this period of time.

5.) A bulletin will be in place where people may sit. Please do not leave the bulletin in the pew. Take it home with you.

6.) There will be no offertory collection during Mass. Please leave your offering in the basket located at the entrances.

7.) Directions for the reception of communion will be given at Mass. We ask that you bring your own hand sanitizer and wash your hands prior to receiving communion.

Although these regulations are inconvenient and cumbersome, they must be adhered to without exception. We cannot take the risk of spreading the virus and Bishop Persico has made it clear that any parish community that does not follow the protocols will be closed to further public worship as we move forward.

In addition, Fr. Chris will hear confessions on Saturdays @ 3:15 – 3:45 pm at St. Philip Church and Sundays @ 7:45 – 8:15 am at St. Peter Church. Once again, we are required to follow all regulations outlined above. Thank you for your cooperation and let us pray for an end to this pandemic and a return to normal life.

Attention Greeters, Ushers, Lectors: As outlined above, there will be no need for Ushers or Greeters. Lectors will be called to see if you are willing to read. As far as Counters—I will let you know by phone.
