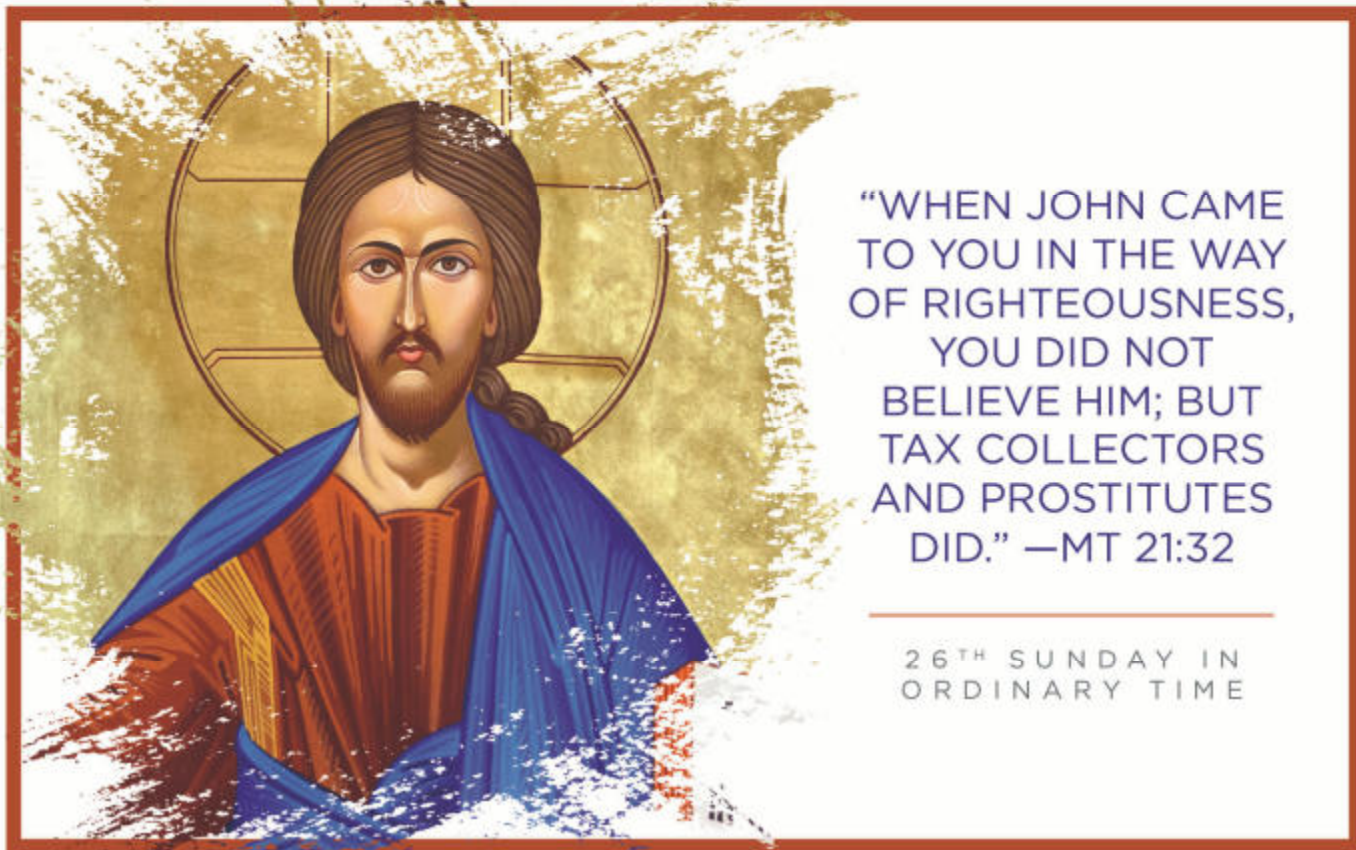

Welcome

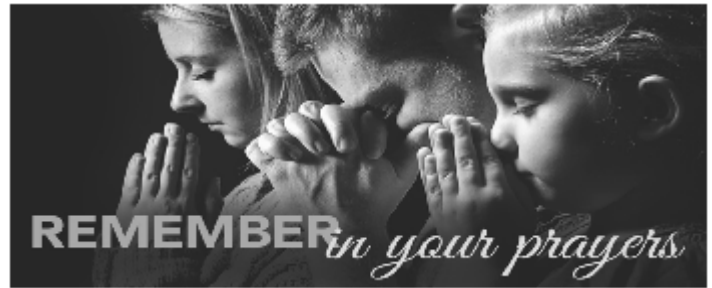
