

#### Notes from the Pastor

PASTORAL PLANNING INPUT MEETINGS: The Preliminary Plan for our area of the Diocese will be presented this weekend. You are invited to make suggestions or improvements to the plan either online on the diocesan website, or you can make those comments in writing and mail them to the diocese. There will be two public meetings to make those suggestions this week. Wednesday, September 6 at St. Thomas in Corry at 6:30pm or Thursday, September 7 at St. Teresa in Union City at 6:30pm. You can also make these suggestions or improvements on your own and do not need to wait for these meetings to do so. Comments must be received at the Diocese of Erie by the end of September. ANOINTING OF THE SICK: We will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick after all the masses on the weekend of September 9 & 10. We ask those taking part in this sacrament to come and sit in the very front row of the church after Mass. This will let us know who is asking to be anointed and facilitate the actual anointing. We would ask others who are remaining in the Church after Mass to be quiet as we celebrate this sacrament. We will also be asking those who are receiving the sacrament to print their names on a paper we pass around that day so we can properly record the sacrament in our sacramental books. Thank You!

Just some reminders about who is eligible for this anointing.

- A person who becomes ill and the illness becomes more serious:
- A person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery;
- Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present;
- Sick children are to be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this sacrament. In a case of doubt whether a child has reached the use of reason, the sacrament is to be conferred;
- Some types of mental illness are now classified as serious.
   Those who are judged to have a serious mental illness and who would be strengthened by the sacrament may be anointed (depression, paranoia, etc.);

In case of doubt as to whether the illness is serious or not, the person should be anointed.

#### New Religious Education Year for 2022-2023

We are finalizing the schedule for the new Religious Education Year and it will be published soon. Parent registration packets



for Religious Education are available in the church at both parishes. Parents are asked to pick up a packet. Religious Education classes will begin on Sunday, September 17<sup>th</sup>. #### <u>Important Parent Meetings for Grades 6—10</u>

### Pastoral Planning

#### PRELIMINARY PLAN for St. Thomas, St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima

On Tuesday the *preliminary* pastoral plan for Erie County was introduced by Bishop Persico. This plan is *preliminary*. You are invited to make suggestions to better the plan or to accept it as it is. Remember that this plan is based on the declining number of priests available to staff parishes and the decreasing number of people attending Mass in parishes throughout the diocese. The **Preliminary** Proposal: St. Teresa of Avila Parish, Union City, with is secondary mission church, Our Lady of Fatima Church in Canadohta Lake, merges into St. Thomas the Apostle, Corry.

St. Teresa of Avila becomes a secondary mission church of St. Thomas the Apostle; Our Lady of Fatima becomes a secondary church of St. Thomas the Apostle.

What does this mean? Currently St. Teresa and St. Thomas are partnered parishes, which means they share a priest, but remain distinct parishes with one parish office and parish staff. Our Lady of Fatima is a mission church of St. Teresa that has seasonal Sunday Mass.

The merger means that St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima parishes are now combined into St. Thomas Parish. St. Teresa will still have Sunday and Holy Day Mass, but Sunday Mass will cease at Our Lady of Fatima. Merging means that all the people, churches, property, assets, debt, etc... of St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima will become consolidated under one parish which is St. Thomas the Apostle.

The two public meetings to make your suggestions and comments are: Wednesday, September 6 at St. Thomas in Corry at 6:30pm or Thursday, September 7 at St. Teresa in Union City at 6:30pm. You can also make these suggestions or improvements on your own and do not need to wait for these meetings to do so. Comments must be received at the Diocese of Erie by the end of September.
