# Notes from the Pastor

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Two weeks ago, we celebrated the anointing of the sick at all the Masses. There were 74 people who were anointed at those Masses. I am grateful to those who came forward to be anointed. It is a reminder to us that often the sick and suffering in our parish go unnoticed. They do not draw attention to themselves, but often struggle quietly with their illness. All those who came forward to be anointed remind the rest of us how fragile our health can be and how we need to be grateful for the good health we have. It also reminds us to pray for those who are struggling with illness every day. The sacrament of the anointing of the sick reminds us that Jesus spent a great part of his ministry reaching out to those who were ill and offered them healing. I am hoping that we will offer this sacrament in a public way after Mass at least twice a year. And know that it is always available by contacting Fr. Tom at the parish office.

Numbers sometimes give us one more perspective on things. We claim to have 589 families registered at the two parishes that translates into 1200 individual members. So, we anointed roughly 6 percent of our parish on that weekend.

I hope that the article in the bulletin on the sacrament of the anointing of the sick, the anointing at Mass, and the First Friday Communion calls have helped to educate people on this sacrament. It is one of the things the Church has actually changed in response to the real needs of people. Change doesn't happen very often in our Church's sacramental life, but this is one that we need to become more aware of and utilize to its fullest potential.

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY: I want to take a moment to express my appreciation to Missy Silka, our Faith Formation Director, and to all those catechists who volunteered to help teach, or be aides, or to help with the behind the scenes work that goes into our Faith Formation Programs. I am very impressed with the quality of teachers and their dedication to their faith. We need to offer them our thanks and our fullest support.

There are new programs for Middle School and Confirmation this year: The Edge program for Middle School and the Purpose program for Confirmation. Any time we start something new there are "bugs" to be worked out in the programs and sometimes technology doesn't always cooperate with our best intentions. But I believe there are some great things happening to benefit our young people.

# A Family Perspective



# Pastoral Planning

The *preliminary* pastoral plan for Erie County was announced. You are invited to make your suggestions and/or comments. Remember that this plan is based on the declining number of priests available to staff parishes and the decreasing number of people attending Mass in parishes throughout the diocese. A complete list of the parishes merged or partnered in this plan can be found at www.ErieRCD.org/planning.html

The **Preliminary** Proposal: St. Teresa of Avila Parish, Union City, with is secondary mission church, Our Lady of Fatima Church in Canadohta Lake, merges into St. Thomas the Apostle, Corry.

St. Teresa becomes a secondary mission church of St. Thomas; Our Lady of Fatima becomes a secondary church of St. Thomas.

The merger means that St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima are now combined into St. Thomas Parish. Saint Teresa will still have Sunday and Holy Day Mass, but Sunday Mass will cease at Our Lady of Fatima. Merging means that all the people, churches, property, assets, debt, etc... of St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima will become consolidated under one parish which is St. Thomas the Apostle.

All parishioners are encouraged to make their suggestions or improvements to the preliminary plan by completing the pastoral planning survey either online or in writing. 
