

Notes from the Pastor

CHRISTMAS SEASON: Unlike our secular world's celebration of Christmas, which is over and done with, the Church celebrates Christmas over several weeks. We have four weeks of Advent to prepare for Christmas, and then we celebrate Christmas Day, then the feast of the Holy Family, and the feast of the Epiphany. Some years we even include the celebration of the Baptism of Jesus. Why? We realize that this feast is so incredibly powerful that we can not contain it in one celebration, but we need to take time to celebrate various aspects of this feast. Please don't allow this feast of God's tremendous love for us go by too quickly. Savor it, ponder it, rejoice in it. Allow the Christ child to be born again in you.

I found this Christmas prayer/blessing several years ago and come back to it every year because it helps me to remember the various aspects of this feast. It is my prayer for you as we continue to celebrate the richness of this season.






