





### THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Anywho, as we continue this adventure together as Partnered Parishes, this marks a big week for our Parishes, as this week we are finally able to combine our Parish Offices into one united Partnered Parish Office located at St. Thomas Church in Corry the former convent/office/rectory....and now office again—which is located directly behind the Church.

2) Our new Partnered Parish Office Staff are the following: Business Manager—Missy Silka; Secretary—Sue Johnston; Bookkeeper—Mary Jane Adamaszek.

It's important for us to note that all current office staff were offered a position in the new Partnered Parish Office some chose to accept a new position, and some chose to move on. We are truly grateful to all the staff of our Parishes—former, current, and new!

3) As we continue to whittle our way down from 19 people on staff—we will gradually work on evaluating all aspects of the life of our Parishes to see how we can better partner to serve our common mission.

4) Beginning Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, the new Partnered Parish Office will be located in the former convent of **St. Thomas Church, 203 West Washington Street, Corry, PA 16407**. The phone number is: **814-663-3041**. We are currently working on new email addresses as well—but the current email addresses will also work for the time being. Similarly, any calls placed to the former office in Union City will be forwarded to the new Partnered Parish Office. But still, it's probably good to update your rolodex with the new phone number. 5) Please repeat #1. A lot!

In all of these things and our life as Partnered Parishes, (2 Parishes, 3 Churches, 3 cemeteries, 10 buildings, 19 staff) growing pains will happen. So let's all just get through it as best as possible with the Grace of God. The kinks will all be worked out—and we will be stronger together.



### Saints Peter and Paul

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles, will be celebrated on Wednesday, June 29. Saints Peter and Paul were martyred around the year 64 AD. Tradition says that Peter fled Rome to avoid arrest and saw Jesus on the road. "Where are you going, Lord," Peter asked. Jesus replied, "I am going to Rome to be crucified again." Peter turned back and was crucified upside down because he felt unworthy to meet his death the same way as Christ. Paul was seized in Jerusalem



and was sent to Rome, where he was placed under house arrest. He was slain by beheading, because as a Roman citizen he could not be subjected to the indignity of crucifixion. In giving their lives, both Peter and Paul followed Christ, who perfectly modeled sacrificial love. We honor their courage and devotion.
