

Notes from the Pastor

PASTORAL PLANNING MEETINGS: I want to thank all of those who came to the Pastoral Planning Meetings during the past two weeks. I was very impressed with the manner in which these discussions took place and the insights and ideas that surfaced during those discussions. I want to thank the members of parish and finance councils who not only met to discuss the plan but also attended the meetings at each parish to hear the insights of others.

I shared some information at those meetings that I think may be helpful to those who were not there. Some people were wondering what the formula or criteria were in order to make these pastoral planning decisions. There were a number of factors that were taken into consideration: population, Mass attendance trends, financial status, unnecessary duplication of ministries and staffing, Mass times, proximity to other parishes, and more. This process started in 2014 and has been ongoing since then and will continue in the years to come. This process not only includes consolidating parishes, but also addressing religious education and faith formation, evangelization, and vocations.

Some of the statistics that I shared at these meetings may be helpful. The population in the diocese of Erie was 875,000 in 1990 and in 2022 the population was 813,000. Mass attendance in 1990 was 120,000 and in 2022 mass attendance was 26,770 (78% decrease). The number of parishes in our diocese in 1990 was 127 and in 2022 the number of parishes was 93. The number of priests in our diocese in 1990 was 210 and in 2022 the number of priests was 92. The projected number of priests for 2030 is 60!

As you can see, the fewer priests and people we have is really the driving force behind the consolidations that are being proposed and have taken place in other places in our diocese.

PARENTS OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION STUDENTS: One of the pieces of the Religious Education and Faith Formation pastoral plan is to increase parent involvement in the religious education of their children. At times, parents have dropped their children off for religious education classes and then really didn't take their role, as the primary educators of their children in the faith, seriously. At times they didn't bring them to church but just dropped them off for class. The pastoral plan is inviting and encouraging parents to take a more active role in the religious education or faith formation of their children. The religious education program is a supplement to the education and formation parents provide by taking their children to church and worshipping together, and by the example of service, prayer, and Christian living that is fostered in the home. I encourage parents to take a more active role in the religious education of their children and in developing your own faith, so that you can more readily pass it on to your children.

ALL LECTORS AND EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS MEETINGS: There will be a meeting for all lectors and Eucharistic Ministers Monday, September 18, at St. Teresa and Tuesday, September 19, at St. Thomas. The meetings will begin at 6:00pm and they will be held in the Church. Fr. Tom and Deacon Randy will be updating and instructing both groups.



Pastoral Planning

The *preliminary* pastoral plan for Erie County was announced. You are invited to make your suggestions and/or comments. Remember that this plan is based on the declining number of priests available to staff parishes and the decreasing number of people attending Mass in parishes throughout the diocese. The **Preliminary** Proposal: St. Teresa of Avila Parish, Union City, with is secondary mission church, Our Lady of Fatima Church in Canadohta Lake, merges into St. Thomas the Apostle, Corry.

St. Teresa becomes a secondary mission church of St. Thomas; Our Lady of Fatima becomes a secondary church of St. Thomas.

The merger means that St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima are now combined into St. Thomas Parish. Saint Teresa will still have Sunday and Holy Day Mass, but Sunday Mass will cease at Our Lady of Fatima. Merging means that all the people, churches, property, assets, debt, etc... of St. Teresa and Our Lady of Fatima will become consolidated under one parish which is St. Thomas the Apostle.

All parishioners are encouraged to make their suggestions or improvements to the preliminary plan by completing the pastoral planning survey either online or in writing. **Comments** must be received at the Diocese of Erie by September 29.
